GROSS MOTOR

Hallway Laser Maze

<u>Supplies</u>: painters tape, roll of crepe paper (paper streamer)

In a hallway, use a roll of crepe paper to create a laser maze for your child to navigate through. Then have your child move through the maze without breaking the crepe paper.

Jello Fossil Dig

<u>Supplies</u>: 2 boxes of jello, plastic dinosaurs, and shallow pan/dish
